

Now available - Danebury Vineyards wines. High quality wine produced in Hampshire.

It may come as a surprise that Hampshire has all the criteria required to produce top class wines - the right climate, soil, aspect and altitude. Although on the fringes of the wine producing regions of the world, England's long summer days allow for maximum ripening of the grapes, ensuring strong fruit flavours!

Why not try a bottle - or a glass - of one of our Danebury Vineyard wines.

Danebury Vineyards is a family owned boutique vineyard located in the heart of Hampshire on the paddocks of what was a famous 19th century racehorse training yard. Their vines were planted in 1988 and today produce their flagship vintage brut sparkling wine and two still white wines. They have decided to focus on limited production following organic principles, so only a small number of bottles is produced each year. We consider it a real privilege to be able to offer these wines at Cassandra's Cup!

All 3 wines have notched up an impressive number of international wine awards. Highly recommended!

Danebury Cossack (vintage sparkling wine 2008) £25 per bottle

- *Made from a blend of Auxerrois Blanc (a Pinot Noir cross breed grape sharing its ancestry with Chardonnay) and Pinot Gris. It is a classically structured wine that lasts on the palate. Delightful on its own or with food. Lime and lemon on the nose, pear and white peach on the palate, rich finish of toasty brioche.*

Danebury Madeleine Angevine 2011 £5 per 125ml glass or £16.95 per bottle

- *this is a low alcohol wine - 9% - and thus contains only 60kcal per glass! Perfect for lunchtime drinking (or those of us watching the waistline...)*
- *It is made using a white wine grape from the Loire Valley, making a delicious fruity wine, similar to Pinot Blanc. Flowery nose, crisp and dry, perfect as an aperitif or paired with seafood.*

Danebury Schönburger 2011 £6 per 125ml glass or £18.95 per bottle

- *made using a hybrid of Pinot Noir, Chasselas and Muscat Hamburg, popularly grown in England. It has a rich, full soft palate exhibiting a refreshing clean finish, making it an excellent accompaniment to fish, chicken and vegetable based dishes.*
